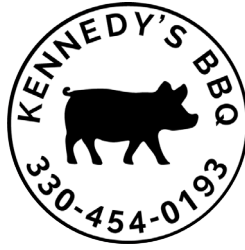

## THE HISTORY OF A CANTON CLASSIC

Kennedy's BBQ originally opened as Spikers BBQ in 1922, this landmark became known as the "Shack on the Track" due to its close proximity to the railroad tracks that cross 7th St. N.W. The Spikers were responsible for the smoke house concept as well as the famous "secret relish" recipe that is still being used today.

In 1960, Jack Kennedy purchased the restaurant, renaming it Kennendy's BBQ and operated the business until his death in 2009. Acquired from Mr. Kennedy's estate by Ernie & Patti Schott, they continue the tradition of the original recipes for smoking meats and classic bean soup.
